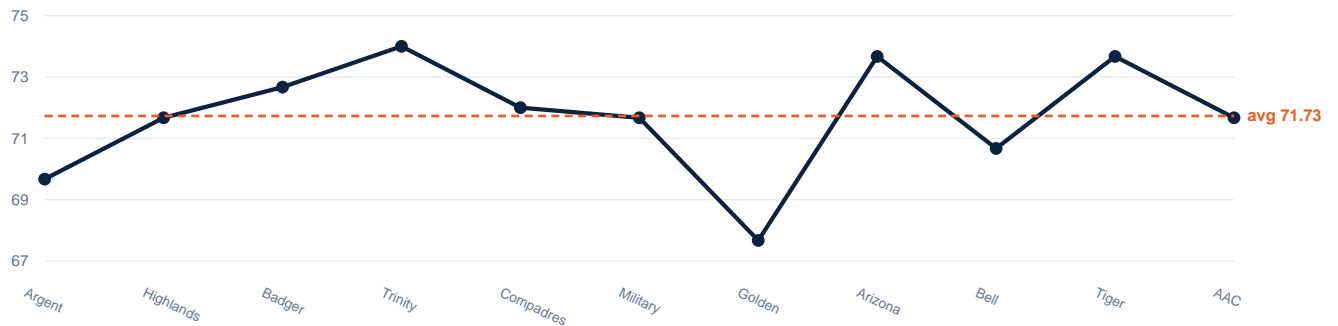

Technical Reading

The season profile is built less on one isolated low round and more on sustained scoring value across a completed freshman sample. Normal freshman volatility appeared in several higher-cost rounds, but the full-season profile remained record-level.

Lineup Reliability

32 of 33 counting team rounds indicates low lineup-risk value. The central transfer value is dependable team-score contribution already tested under NCAA travel, course setup, academics, and team-score responsibility.

Championship Close

At the American Conference Championship, Joshua opened 73-73 and closed with 69 to finish under par. The result preserved the season profile and showed final-round correction rather than late-season collapse.
